Dubia Fortuna – unique interpretation of historic music

The group is composed of four different personalities, four musicians who in their unique way seek to bring historic music closer to people who normally prefer other musical genres.

Their repertoire includes mainly profane Mediaeval music – songs and music of banquets, feasts and markets. The songs originate from Europe (Czech, France, Germany, Italy, Turkey...) and are always sung in their respective original languages.

At concerts we use replicas of original instruments, including reed-pipes, flutes, cisters, fidulae and different kinds of percussions and other drums. We usually add explanation concerning the instruments used. The Mediaeval atmosphere of good humor, exuberance and cheerfulness is reinforced by proper historical costumes.

During the several years of our existence we have gathered rich experience: each year we perform at about a hundred concerts at home and abroad, we recorded our own CD „Esta Mesa” and „In Taberna Mundus”.



Dubia Fortuna in Latin means „changing fortune” but can also be translated as “dubious happiness”. Either way, these Latin words sum up the nature of our group – high efforts, directness, humor and distance and at the same time keeping the character of the period.
